STICKIES CAN SPELL FOR YOU

The Tiger OS for Mac introduced us to Widgets. One of my favorite Widgets is Stickies, the little yellow notepad that looks like the sticky notes some of you tend to plaster all over your monitor.

To use Stickies, click on the Dashboard icon in the doc, and then click on the + sign in the lower left corner of your screen. Now you can drag the Stickies icon up to your Dashboard.

If you want to spell check a word you typed in a Stickies note, just Control click on the Word and a contextual menu will appear. At the top of that menu will be choices for what it believes to be the proper spelling of that word if the word is misspelled and Stickies recognizes the word in the first place.

If you agree, just move your cursor over that word, release your mouse button, and your misspelled word will be replaced with the correct spelling.
