USE MOUSE TO HIGHLIGHT ADDRESS BAR IN SAFARI

In lesson 18, I showed you how to highlight the address bar in Mac's Safari Web browser by holding down the Command key and pressing the letter L. But then again, that's a keyboard shortcut, and some Mac users would rather use the mouse and not the keyboard. That's OK we can do that.

The fastest one-click method in town is to just click on the Apple icon (or custom site icon) that you will find just before the Web address in that field. That will instantly highlight the field, and you can type the new Internet URL over the old URL. It's fast and it's easy.
