SECRET SCREEN CAPTURE SHORTCUTS

As you surf the net you'll see things on your screen from time to time that you'll want to keep. That's really easy to do. The shortcut most Apple OS X users reach for to capture a screen shot is Command-Shift-3 to capture the entire screen, or Command-Shift-4, which gives you a crosshair cursor so you can choose which area of the screen you want to capture.

Each time you capture a screenshot, it will appear on your desktop labeled with the word Picture and a number. For example, you might see icons on your Desktop labeled Picture 1 and Picture 2.

I use this shortcut frequently. It really helps.
