QUICKLY HIGHLIGHT SAFARI ADDRESS BAR

When I use the Mac Safari Web Browser, I used to drag my cursor over the address of the Web site I was looking at in order to highlight it and type in the URL of the next Web site I wanted to look at. That was slow and a bit clumsy as well. I now use a much faster shortcut to highlighting the Safari Address Bar. It's easy.

Just hold down the Command key and press the letter L. That automatically highlights the Safari Address Bar so all I have to do is start typing in the new URL. Believe me, it's much easier and it's faster too.
