

## VISTA LESSON 2

### FIND THE RUN AND THE SHUTDOWN COMMANDS

The RUN command does not appear on the Vista start menu, as it has on XP and several other previous versions of Windows. You could restore it with a bit of Registry tweaking, but there is an easier way. Press and release the Windows key or click on the Start menu, which doesn't say Start but is still located in the lower left corner of your screen, type the letter R, and press the Enter key. That brings up the RUN dialog box.

By default, Vista shuts down to the Hibernation mode. To turn a Vista-equipped computer completely off, click on the arrow at the lower right corner of the Start menu and select Shutdown.
