MAKE THE START BUTTON SHUT VISTA DOWN

By default, using the Start button to turn off your Vista-equipped computer actually places your computer in "Sleep" mode.

Open the Control Panel. If you are using the Normal view, click on System Maintenance, then on Power Options. Now click on Change what the power buttons do.

If you are using the Classic view, open Power Options and click on Change advanced Power Settings and then select Expand Power Buttons and Lid.

Now you can change what the Power button will do when you push it and change what the Start menu power button will do.

You can choose between do nothing, sleep, hibernate and shut down.

Click OK to close and exit and you're done. It's that easy.
