SHOW THE 'MY COMPUTER' ICON ON THE DESKTOP

One of the most useful places in Windows XP, and now in Windows Vista, is the 'My Computer' section, which give you access to all of your drives, both internal and external, and all of your documents, all in the same place.

I always place a 'My Computer' icon on my desktop. The 'My Computer' shortcut appeared on the Desktop in earlier versions of Windows, including 98, ME and 2000.

So if you find having a Desktop shortcut to 'My Computer' useful, here's how to make it happen in Vista.

Click on the Start button and then right-click on 'My Computer'. Now click Show on Desktop and that's it - your done. The 'My Computer' shortcut icon now appears on your Desktop. It's that easy.
